New PPA Tool in the Community Wind Toolbox

We're excited to announce that the Community Wind Toolbox is now a little bigger with the addition of a new section about Power Purchase Agreements. A power purchase agreement (PPA) is a contract to buy the electricity generated by a power plant. These agreements are a critical part of planning a successful wind project because they secure a long-term stream of revenue for the project through the sale of the electricity generated by the project. Securing a good PPA is often one of the most challenging elements of wind project development.
